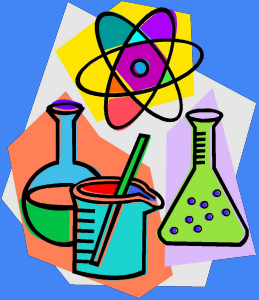

- LATE WORK / NO NAME WORK will NOT be entered online immediately.

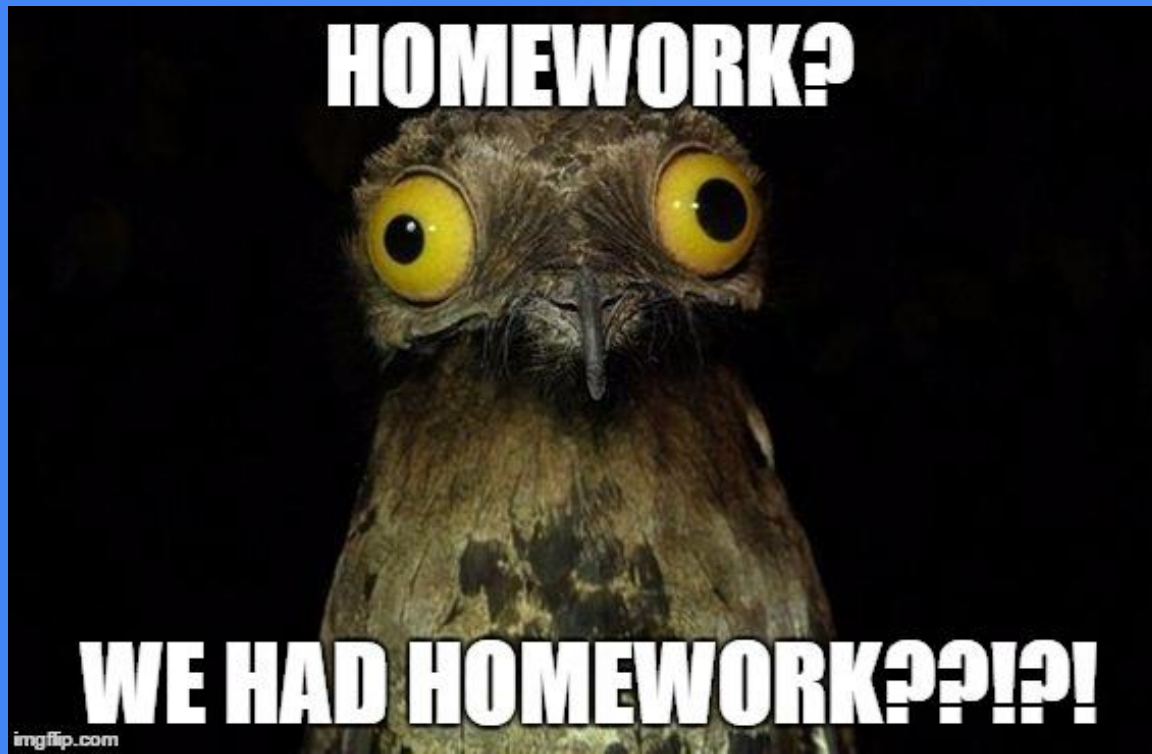
DAILY HOMEWORK...

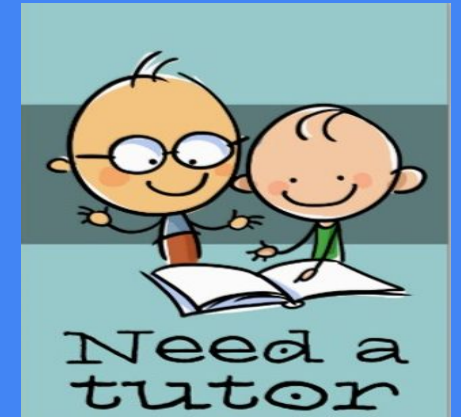

- Teachers may sign students up for Homework Recovery if they get behind in their work.

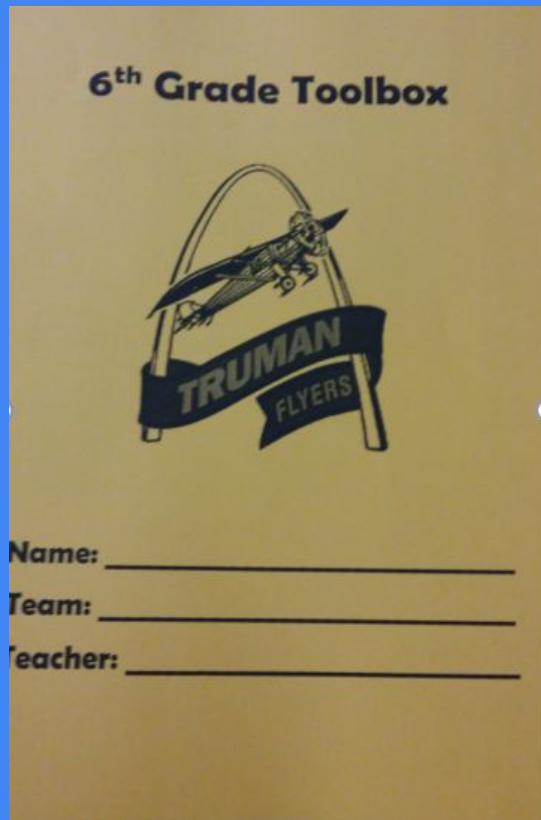


ADDITIONAL INFORMATION...

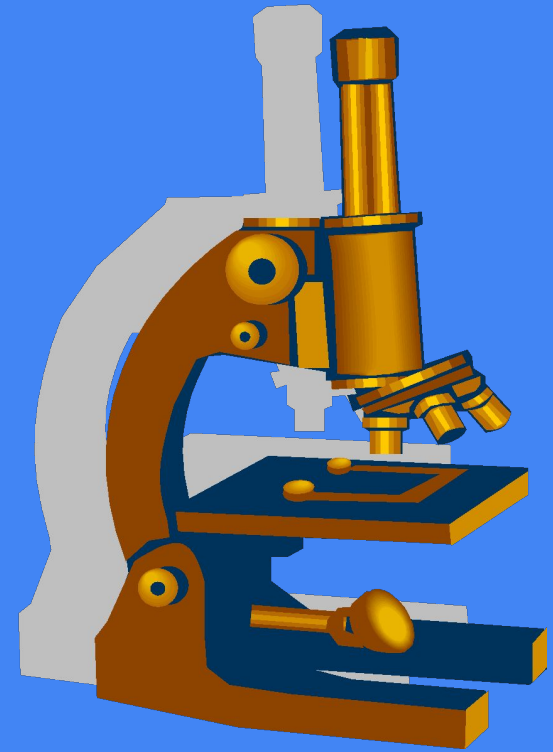

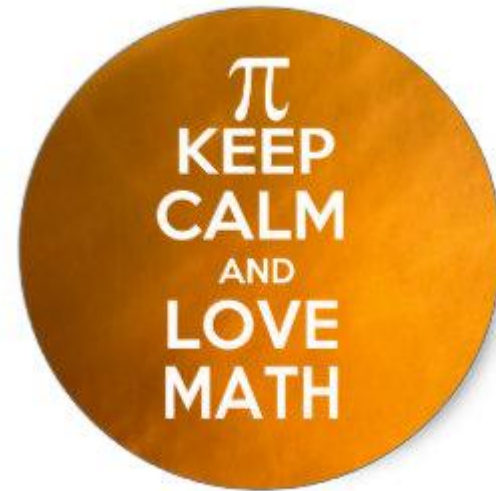

- Homework is PRACTICE.
- MOST homework is graded on EFFORT.
- Write out problems, SHOW WORK, and circle answers.
- Students grade their own homework so they can MAKE CORRECTIONS and ASK QUESTIONS.

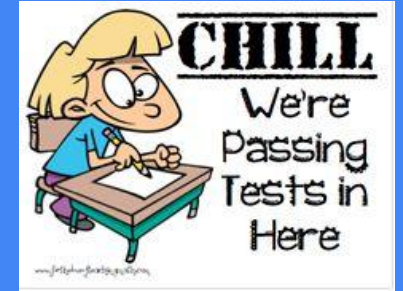
NO TEARS IN MATH!!

- Homework is PRACTICE.
Students should TRY every problem.
- Your child should NOT be up late at night crying over their math homework!
- Sign off on the homework and have him/her go to bed.

- Two tests per chapter (testing half the chapter)
- Tests are divided into sections with a grade given for each section.
- This gives feedback for you and your child of his/her strengths and weaknesses.

To be eligible to retake a math test:

- Students may retake one or more sections of your math tests. The higher grade will be recorded on SIS.
- Students must complete (with work shown) the section (s) of the extra practice worksheet that corresponds to the section (s) of the test that you wish to retake and do test corrections when we go over it in class.
- Grade your worksheet prior to doing the retake. Make sure to ASK for help on any problems you got wrong on the worksheet.
